I. Elections:

- a. Blake Hollingsworth is stepping down as President and taking a new role as chair for the fundraising committee.
- b. Band Booster Executive Board includes:
 - i. President: Brooke Ostler
 - ii. Vice President: Jenny Campbell
 - iii. Treasurer: Carina Blacker
 - iv. Treasurer elect: Mindy Stoker
 - v. Secretary: Kristi Pugh

II. Blake explained the different Committees that are needed to run the band program. Fundraising is a vital part of the program. It is an arm to assist the kids with the fees that are associated with band. Also fundraising for the program will aid in instrument repair, to buy new instrument s, etc.

a. Fundraising:

- i. Blake will spearhead this committee. He is asking for help for ideas. He stated that we really need help with the student fundraisers.
- ii. McCain's Coordinator: Mr. and Mrs. Bliss volunteered to be the coordinators for this fundraiser.
- iii. Fair Booth: The Executive Board will be heading this for this year. We are looking for someone to be able to take this over in the future.
 - 1. Morey's is helping with the booth this year. They are providing a reduced menu of what they serve. Whatever we do not use will go back to Tracey. All the prep work will be done at Morey's. There will be an order line and a pick-up line to hopefully streamline the process. Steve Wozniak (Sp?) offered to help with the fair booth. Fair week is August 15th through the 23rd.

- iv. Chocolate fundraiser: This is a Fine Arts department fundraiser. The kids will have 1 week to sell the chocolates on campus and three additional weeks to sell off of campus. (4 weeks total). Blake stated that we need someone to help signing out the boxes and collecting the money. Nicole Gee stated that she would assist with this fundraiser.
- v. Little Caesars Fundraiser: We need someone who can contact the fundraiser program. Come to the band and introduce the fundraiser. Be in the band room to collect the money and also be there for distribution day. Nicole Gee stated that she would be will to work this fundraiser as well.
- vi. Big Program Fundraiser: Blake stated that we are look at raising \$25,000 far various things that the band needs. This would include new drum equipment, instrument repairs and a new trailer to haul equipment.
- vii. Marching Committee: This committee would assist with the props that need to be made and help get chaperones for the various competitions that the marching band has. We are looking for people to assist with this committee.
- viii. Administrative Committee: this committee would assist with getting the waivers signed, help with the apparel for the band (tuxes, dresses, shirts, sweatshirts) and clerical. Mary Jane Ricks and Deborah Jackson volunteered to assist with this committee.
- ix. Magic Valley Competition: This is our home competition. "All hands on deck" for this. It takes all of us to put this competition on. Mr. and Mrs. Talbot are willing to chair this.
- x. Cookbooks: 382 recipes have been collected. The price is \$15 per cookbook. They will make great gifts. The band is ordering 300 copies to sell.
- xi. Pizza Hut Fundraiser: This is every 4th Monday of the month. (Next Monday the 27th). All NPC Pizza Huts can use the code for the band. Watch for announcements so that you can help by reposting it on Facebook.
- b. Virtual Competition: Tim is looking into a virtual competition for the marching band. He will get back to us regarding the details.
- c. Fees for Band:
 - i. Band Camp: \$150.00
 - ii. Instrument rental fee: \$125.00 for the year
 - iii. Uniform fees: \$75.00
 - iv. Shoes: \$35.00
 - v. Gloves: \$5.00
 - vi. Hoodie: \$50.00
 - vii. Concert dress: \$55.00+ (estimate)
 - viii. Tux: \$115.00+ (estimate) there might be a possible consignment for used tux.
 - ix. Program Fundraiser: if someone opts out of participating in the program fundraiser there is an opt out with a fee of \$25.00 per Program Fundraiser.

- x. You can pay online at burleybobcatbands.com . The fees can be paid with the green button for school fees. If returning students have a credit, they can use those credits to pay for their fees.
- III. Friday Band Camp Day: Performance will be at 5:30 for the families. The band will be working on team building exercises. Possibly having the Burley Fire department show up with their trucks. After the show, there will be a signup for the fair booth for students and parents to work.
